## Youthprise trained **8** YouthBank pilot sites in **2015**.

These are the first U.S. based sites utilizing the YouthBank International model.

### **Brooklyn Bridge Alliance for Youth (BBA) Brooklyn Park/Brooklyn Center, Minnesota.**

BBA's mission is to coordinate a system of high quality, accessible and fully resourced opportunities that lead to an increase in high school graduation and pathways to college or career and reductions in young people's experience of violence.

### **New Lens Urban Mentoring Saint Paul, Minnesota.**

New Lens Urban Mentoring Society is a partnership between Saint Paul Public Schools and the Saint Paul Public Schools Foundation. Its mentorship program is designed to address the mental, physical and social development needs of black males who attend the Saint Paul Public Schools.

### **Northfield Healthy Community Initiative (HCI) Northfield, Minnesota.**

Northfield HCI's mission is to cultivate a collaborative community that supports, values and empowers youth.

### **Save Our Schools (SOS) Minneapolis, Minnesota.**

SOS invests in educational opportunities for at-risk students of the Twin Cities. Championing collaboration between students and staff, SOS is impacting the community from within the classroom walls and beyond. SOS provides the platform that allows its supporters to allocate 100% of their donations, resources and volunteer support to programs and classrooms, where it is needed most.

### **Saint Paul Youth Commission (Sprockets) Saint Paul, Minnesota.**

Sprockets improves the quality, availability and effectiveness of out-of-school time learning for all youth in Saint Paul through the committed, collaborative and innovative efforts of community organizations, government, schools and other partners. The Saint Paul Youth Commission is a place for young people in Saint Paul to have a voice at City Hall to tackle community issues that help create a better Saint Paul for youth.

**Suburban Ramsey Family Collaborative (SRFC) Roseville, Minnesota.** SRFC is a partnership between schools, county, public health, corrections, nonprofit agencies, mental health service providers, faith communities and youth organizations to improve formal and informal support systems for children, youth and families, with a focus on wellness, learning safety, and security.

### **YMCA of the Greater Twin Cities Saint Paul, Minnesota.**

The University YMCA is a cause-driven organization committed to developing the ethical leadership capacities of students in a context of social issues: youth development, healthy living, and social responsibility.

### **Youthprise Minneapolis, Minnesota.**

Youthprise's mission is to champion learning beyond the classroom so that all Minnesota youth thrive. Youthprise engages youth in the design and implementation of quality learning programs, policy systems, philanthropy, and research and evaluation.

Pilot sites commit to a minimum of 3 years of re-granting through Youthbank

Each site will complete at least one round of grantmaking in 2015

Sites are provided with a 3.5 day orientation and training process to effectively implement the Youthbank International model into their sites

Hosts are provided with technical assistance, learning community meetings, training on grantmaking, matched dollars and celebratory events

Pilot sites receive an initial \$10,000 investment from Youthprise to re-grant into their communities and have access to an additional dollar for dollar leverage match up to \$15,000
