We are not looking for someone to explain last month's accounts. We are looking for someone to help us answer: How do we finance the next decade?

We run lean, we routinely carry some projected financial risk, and we have always found a way forward. We are now building something more durable than grant-to-grant survival.

What we need:

Our board has been clear that the treasurer we need is as much about income and opportunity as about compliance. We are looking for someone who can help us with:

- cashflow forecasting and scenario planning in an organisation where the picture is often tight
- income diversification — earned income, consultancy, partnership agreements, subscriptions — alongside grants
- thinking about investment in our own capability, including digital products, as a genuine asset
- pricing and the honest tension between what we charge and what delivery actually costs in staff time



- helping the whole board read, challenge and understand the numbers — not simply receive them

The essentials that come with the role:

Proper records and controls, restricted and unrestricted funds, reserves, statutory reporting, and working with those who examine our accounts. Where these are new to you, the board and executive will support you and we can arrange training.

Who we are hoping to hear from:

A formal accountancy qualification is welcome but is not a requirement. We are equally interested in people from social enterprise, finance, business development or mixed-income models who are comfortable with uncertainty, oriented towards how money comes in, and calm when things are tight. What we will not compromise on is integrity, sound judgement, and a real belief in young people holding decision-making power.

The commitment.

Around 8 board meetings a year plus occasional additional calls, and regular contact with the Executive Director between meetings, held online across a wide spread of time zones (our network runs from roughly six hours behind us to six hours ahead). This is a voluntary role; reasonable expenses are reimbursed.
